APPLICATION AND TUITION FEES

1. APPLICATION AND PLACEMENT TEST FEES

Application and placement test fee per student:..... THB 6,000

This is a one-time fee for all new students. The fee is waived for the third and each additional child.

2. ENROLLMENT FEE (NON-REFUNDABLE)

New student enrollment fee per student THB 80,000

Enrollment fee: 2nd and each additional child THB 60,000

Enrollment fee: starting at A Level per student THB 40,000

This **non-refundable** fee is due within the dates stipulated in the placement report.

Sibling discounts: Sibling discounts for tuition fees: a 5% discount for the second child and a 10% discount for the third and any additional children.

Included: Tuition, field trips/excursions (day trips only), external examinations (Key Stage 2 – 5), learning supplies and materials, first aid, and accident insurance supplement

Excluded: Early years – Key Stage 2 lunch, uniforms, student visa, textbooks (vary by year groups and subjects), overnight field trips and special activities (e.g., Duke of Edinburgh or DoE, Model United Nations or MUN, Travel & Tourism Project), examination fees for additional subjects or re-takes, and Pearson Edexcel fees for Key Stage 5.

Note: Students progressing to Year 11 and Year 13 in the 2025-2026 academic year are required to pay additional examination fees at 50% of the standard rate (as outlined in item 6) for the subjects they will be sitting, as these fees were not averaged or included in the previous year's tuition and fees. 7. STUDENT VISA

In order to obtain a student visa, tuition fees must be paid in full for the current semester. The cost of the visa is the parent's responsibility. The school will provide the school documentation only, to support the student's visa application.

8. UNIFORM FEE

All students must wear VCIS uniforms. The cost of the school uniform is available in the Uniform Shop. Uniforms should be pre-ordered by contacting the uniform shop in person, once the enrollment fee has been paid.

9. OVERNIGHT FIELDTRIPS AND EXCURSIONS

Students participating in overnight field trips, excursions, or special activities (e.g., the Duke of Edinburgh Award, Model United Nations (MUN), or the Travel & Tourism Project) will incur additional costs, which will vary depending on the destination and its distance from the school or Chiang Mai.

Secondary students enrolling in the Duke of Edinburgh Award (DoE) are required to pay a registration fee of THB 2,000, in addition to any costs for excursions organised by the school as part of the award programme.

10. BOOK FEES AND LIBRARY BOOKS

- For secondary students, additional costs will apply for printed and online textbooks, with prices varying depending on the subjects chosen. An invoice for these fees will be issued after the semester begins.
- For Early Years and Primary students, textbooks are included in the tuition fees.

11. LIBRARY BOOKS FEES

Students from Early Years to Year 11 are required to borrow books from the library for study and research purposes. All borrowed books must be signed out. In the event of damage, loss, or failure to return a book by the due date, students will be required to pay compensation equivalent to the current market price of the book.

PAYMENT PROCEDURES FOR TUITION AND FEES

1. PAYMENTS

Payments may be made by the following methods:

1. Pay in cash in person at the VCIS Finance Office.
2. Pay by Visa or MasterCard in person at the VCIS Finance Office. A surcharge of 1.7% will be levied.

2. PAYMENT DUE DATES

Semester 1.....8 August 2025

Semester 2..... 9 January 2026

3. LATE PAYMENT PENALTIES

A late payment fee of THB 1,000 per week will be applied until the outstanding amount is fully settled. If payment is not completed by the mid-term deadlines—10th October 2025 for the first semester and 27th March 2026 for the second semester—the student's name will be removed from the classroom system, and they will not be permitted to attend classes.

4. PAYMENT PLANS

Parents of students who have been enrolled for more than two semesters and are unable to pay the full tuition fees by the specified deadline may contact the Finance Department to arrange a payment plan, ensuring that the outstanding amount is settled within the 16th of June of each year. A late payment fee will also apply.

5. REFUND FOR TUITION AND ADDITIONAL FEES OF SERVICES NOT RECEIVED

<u>New students</u> Withdrawal within seven business days after the start of a semester	<u>Refundable Amount</u> 75% of tuition fees
<u>Current students</u> If tuition fees and other charges have been paid before the start of the semester and the student wishes to withdraw, the withdrawal request must be submitted at least 15 days prior to the start of the semester in order to be eligible for a refund of the tuition and any additional fees paid, as well as to receive academic reports.	
<u>New and current students</u> Withdrawal at any other time or leaves within a semester, regardless of the reason	No refunds or discount for the period

6. EXTENSION OF STATUS AND RETURNING STUDENT PROCEDURES

1. Students requesting a suspension of studies and intending to return within 6 months must pay a status extension fee of THB 2,500 per semester and will be exempt from the new student enrolment fee.
2. Students requesting a suspension of studies and intending to return within 6 to 12 months must pay the status extension fee for both semesters, totalling THB 5,000. They will be required to pay 20% of the standard new student enrolment fee.
3. If the suspension period exceeds 12 months and the student wishes to return, they must follow all procedures for new student enrolment.
4. In cases where tuition fees remain unpaid prior to the suspension period, students must settle any outstanding fees from the previous semester in full before becoming eligible to reapply for enrolment.

Notes:

- ***The school reserves the right to amend the fees without prior notice. The tuition fees and other charges will be revised again in the academic year 2027/2028.***
- ***Examination fees will be subject to change annually.***
